CIRCULAR TO KZN GAMING AND BETTING INDUSTRY

13 July 2021

To All Gaming and Betting Licensees

RE: GAMING AND BETTING INDUSTRY AND PROTEST ACTION IN THE PROVINCE OF KZN

As you are aware the Province of KwaZulu-Natal has been inundated with violent protests and looting taking place sporadically in different Central Business Districts and Suburbs. We note that our licensee's sites are located within these aforementioned areas.

We have received reports from some of our gaming and betting licences that they have incurred damage to their premises, theft of fixtures and equipment as a result of the recent violent protests.

On behalf of Chairperson, Board members, Chief Executive Officer and staff, we would like to express our concern about the perilous threat that these current protests and looting are posing to the gaming and betting industry.

We would like to empathise with licensees within the gaming and betting industry who have incurred various losses during this period. During this difficult period we implore you to stay calm, stay vigilant and most of all stay safe.

The KZNGBB would like to obtain a comprehensive understanding of the damage and loss that has been incurred as a result of the looting and violence, please note that staff members from the KZN Gaming and Betting Board will be contact with yourselves to discuss further.


